Not sure where to Begin?

Starting the process doesn't have to be scary!

1. To receive services with FSJACL, you or your loved one must first receive approval from CLBC. The individual seeking services needs to be at least 19 years of age to receive services from FSJACL, but the process can begin as early as 16 years old.

2. To be referred, contact the CLBC branch in Dawson Creek and request to speak with a Facilitator. They will be the one that guides you through the required documentations and assessments. When you clarify that you want services with FSJACL, the referral will be sent to us.

3. When eligibility is approved, the referral gets sent to our Director of Services. From there, our Manager will contact you to schedule a meeting.
