THIS OATH OF CONFIDENTIALITY APPLIES TO

Disclosed in secret-entrusted with another's' confidentiality

Classified-private-privy-secret-restrictedundisclosed

All staff (i.e. management, line staff, and administration, all members of the board of directors, all committee members, practicum students, advocates, and volunteers.)

I, _____ understand that confidential information is any information, verbal or non-verbal or written, obtained from the client, the clients' family, advocates or volunteers, management, co-workers from your program(s), or coworkers from other programs and any related professional.

I further understand that a breach of confidential information entails the disclosure, either verbal or non-verbal, or written, or any information related to the Fort St. John Association for Community Living in any setting.

I understand that the disclosure of such confidential information could have a serious and detrimental effect on the clients, their families, staff, and the Fort St. John Association for Community Living.

Therefore, I agree that given the severity of a breech of confidential information, such a breech will be grounds for immediate dismissal.

I further understand that the oath of confidentiality is still in effect even after I leave the employment of the Fort St. John Association for Community Living.

Civil action in a court of law could result if there is a breech.
